Hi Jason,

I am writing in response to the letter you sent to all City Council offices last Thursday. I wanted to provide an update on where we are in the process. Final selections of the Commission members are being made, a job posting for the staff position will be going live any day, and we are working on finalizing the scope of work for the Commission. Attached is the current draft of the scope of work which discusses some of the items raised in your letter. I hope you will share this to your institutional partners at Portland Interfaith Clergy Resistance, Disability Rights Oregon, and Oregon Justice Resource Center. We would love feedback from any of you on this draft. We are hoping to bring it to Council June 30<sup>th</sup>, which means it would need to be filed June 22<sup>nd</sup>, and so I ask for feedback by Wednesday June 16<sup>th</sup> so I have time to review and incorporate any proposed edits.

Our office continues to be resistant to requests to set dates for any step of this process. While we appreciate the community's interest in this work being completed as soon as possible we are focused on ensuring the work is done correctly. We welcome any feedback you have.
